Science Task – Skittles Investigation

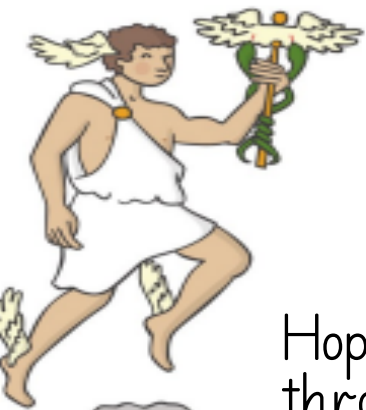
What you need:
