Here is an easy to do, but tricky to understand experiment to show how water changes how light travels. All you need is a glass full of water, a piece of paper and a marker pen.



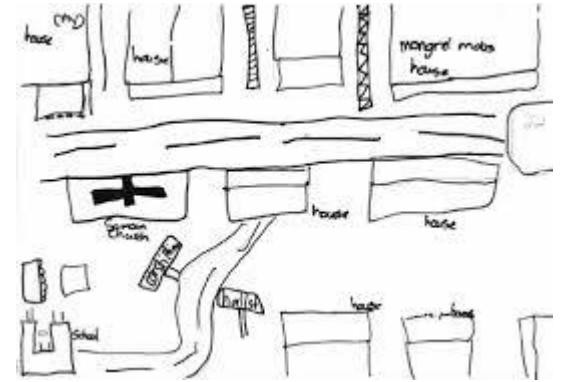
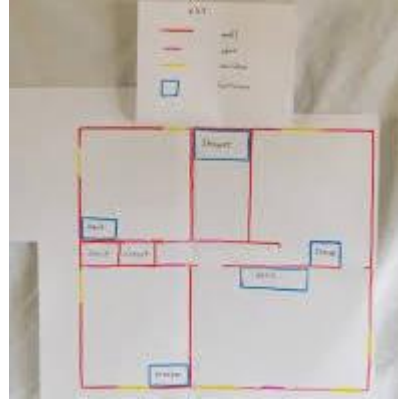
